As a Floridian age 60+, we are struggling with even with the small increase in Social Security. An increase on our monthly power bill adds up for people, like myself, who are on a limited income. While an estimated \$8 a month sounds insignificant, on top of a \$180 Gulf Power electric bill in the summer hurts, trust me. We already keep our house warmer in the summer than we'd like, at 78, to try to keep costs down. I would hope that this proposed increase be examined very closely to see if it is needed and how much. This electric bill increase is not the only cost that is increasing and God help us if gas prices go up this year !
