#### RESOLUTION NO. R-551-19

RESOLUTION URGING THE FLORIDA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION TO APPROVE FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S "FPL SOLARTOGETHER" PROPOSAL THAT WOULD ALLOW CUSTOMERS TO DIRECTLY SUPPORT THE EXPANSION OF SOLAR ENERGY IN FLORIDA AND RECEIVE CREDIT ON FUTURE BILLS FOR THE SAVINGS GENERATED

WHEREAS, Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") has proposed a new community solar program that would present FPL customers with the opportunity to directly support the expansion of solar energy in Florida and participate in Florida's transformation to a global leader in solar energy; and

WHEREAS, the new voluntary program, called "FPL SolarTogether," aims to significantly expand solar energy in Florida through the installation of 1,490 megawatts of new universal solar energy at 20 new solar power plants across FPL's service area to meet anticipated customer enrollment in the program; and

WHEREAS, FPL estimates that the new solar power plants will generate \$139 million in net savings for customers over the long term, primarily from avoided fuel usage and other system savings; and

WHEREAS, upon implementation, the "FPL SolarTogether" program would be the largest community solar program in the United States, as FPL expects it to double the amount of community solar energy available throughout the country; and

WHEREAS, according to Eric Silagy, FPL's president and CEO, the company has "been aggressively expanding solar with one goal in mind: bringing more solar to all of our customers cost-effectively while continuing to keep their bills lower than 90 percent of the country"; and

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WHEREAS, this Board recently adopted Resolution No. R-58-19, authorizing the County Mayor to enter into a preregistration agreement for the "FPL SolarTogether" program on behalf of the County; and

WHEREAS, this Board now wishes to further support the program by urging the PSC to approve FPL's proposal,

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Urges the Florida Public Service Commission to approve Florida Power & Light Company's "FPL SolarTogether" proposal that would allow customers to directly support the expansion of solar energy in Florida and receive credit on future bills for the savings generated.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit certified copies of this resolution to the chairperson, members, and executive director of the Florida Public Service Commission.
