Staff's First Data Request

Re: Docket No. 20190128-GU - Petition for Approval of Transportation Service Agreement for Polk County with the Florida Division of Chesapeake Utilities Corporation by Peninsula Pipeline Company, Inc.

Dear Ms. Keating:

By this letter, Commission staff requests that Peninsula Pipeline Company (Peninsula) and Chesapeake Utilities Corporation (CFG) provide responses to the following data requests:

1. Please provide cost estimates for the expansion as shown in the table below:

Description	Cost	Location
1,200 ft. 12 in. steel (existing)		South and west of Derby Ave., from Gulfstream Gate Station to CFG south of Derby Ave., to the east of Calpine
13,000 ft. 10 in. steel (existing)		From CFG's Blue Lake Gate Station to the south of Derby Ave. to the east of Calpine
800 ft. 6 in. polyethylene (new construction)		From the new interconnect north to CFG's distribution system near Derby Ave.
Regulator		Lake Blue Gate Station

2. Please provide a brief description of the approvals required by Peninsula from any other state or local agencies to complete the projects.
3. When does Peninsula anticipate pipeline construction will begin and end for the 800 feet of 6 inch polyethylene pipeline and the regulator at the Lake Blue Gate Station?
4. Please describe the manner in which Peninsula will recover its associated costs for installing the pipeline.

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5. Please identify and explain the types of costs that the monthly reservation charge as shown on Exhibit A to the Agreement is designed to recover.
6. Per Article II of the Agreement, should Exhibit A include an Unauthorized Use Rate? Please explain.
7. Did CFG issue a Request for Proposals (RFP) to obtain construction cost estimates for the pipeline from other entities? If so, please identify all respondents to the RFP and provide an explanation regarding why their proposals were rejected. If not, please state why CFG did not solicit competitive bids.
8. Please explain how CFG plans to recover its payments to Peninsula pursuant to the Agreement.
9. Please discuss how many residential, commercial, and industrial customers are expected to take service from this expansion project.
