Thank you for your customer correspondence in which you expressed concerns regarding the application for a rate increase by Placid Lakes Utilities, Inc. To ensure that the Commission staff and the Commissioners have knowledge of your concerns, your comments have been placed in the correspondence section of the docket file for all to review.

The Commission's staff makes a recommendation regarding the overall quality of service provided by a utility after evaluating: (1) the quality of the utility's product; (2) the operating conditions of the utility's facilities; and, (3) the utility's attempt to address customers' satisfaction. As part of this evaluation Commission staff reviews sanitary surveys, outstanding citations, violations, and consent orders on file with the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP). Commission staff additionally reviews complaints regarding secondary water quality standards for a five year period and considers customer comments and complaints. Secondary water standards regulate debris in water as well as contaminants that may impact the taste odor, and color of drinking water. Staff's recommendation is scheduled to tentatively be filed on November 26, 2019. A copy of the recommendation can be obtained from the Commission's website located www.floridapsc.com.
