RESPONSE; Since a portion of new service area is north of County Road 468 it is not completely accurate to say County Road 468 borders the new service area on the north, so I have used the term abutting County Road 468.
- 5. Rule 25-30.030(4)(g), F.A.C., requires that the notice include a statement that the utility is not requesting any changes to its rates, classifications, charges, rules, and regulations in the application. Please amend the notice to include this statement. *RESPONSE: See attached revised Notice*.
