**Re: Docket No. 20190170-WS - Application for transfer of facilities and Certificate Nos. 259-W and 199-S in Broward County from Royal Utility Company to Royal Waterworks, Inc.**

Dear Mr. Rendell:

Florida Public Service Commission (Commission) staff has reviewed the application for transfer of facilities submitted by Royal Waterworks, Inc. (Applicant or Utility) on August 29, 2019. After review, we find the application to be deficient. The specific deficiencies are identified as:

1. **Corporation Documentation.** Rule 25-30.037(2)(f)(1), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), requires the buyer to provide documentation from the Florida Department of State, Division of Corporations, showing the utility's/buyer's business name and registration/document number for the business, unless operating as a sole proprietor. Please provide documentation from the Florida Department of State, Division of Corporations (Sunbiz), showing the buyer's business name and registration/document number for the business.
2. **Ownership Address.** Rule 25-30.037(2)(g), F.A.C., requires the names, addresses, and percentage of ownership of each entity or person that owns or will own more than 5 percent interest in the utility. Please provide the addresses for each person that owns more than 5 percent interest in the Utility.
3. **Permits.** Rule 25-30.037(2)(r)(1), F.A.C., requires the applicant to provide a copy of all current permits from the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the water management district (WMD). The Applicant provided permits; however, the WMD permit is in the seller's name. Please provide documentation showing that the WMD permit is being transferred to the Applicant.

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4. **Reports.** Rule 25-30.037(2)(r)(2), F.A.C., requires the applicant to provide a copy of the most recent DEP and/or county health department sanitary survey, compliance inspection report, and secondary standards drinking water report. Please provide the most recent secondary standard test results.

Your petition will not be deemed filed until the deficiencies identified in this letter have been corrected. These corrections should be submitted no later than **December 9, 2019**, to the following address:
