

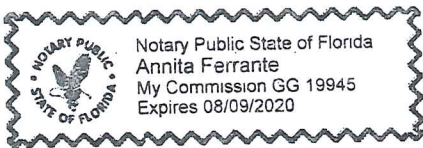

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Rule 25-30.446, Florida Administrative Code, that Aquarina Utilities, Inc. has filed a petition for a water and wastewater limited proceeding rate increase with the Florida Public Service Commission. The general reasons for the requested increase is to (1) recover the cost associated with capital projects, and (2) for a revenue neutral rate restructure to recover revenues lost when the golf course ceased being a non-potable water customer.
