<u>ISSUE 4</u> :	Should the Commission approve FPL's proposed SolarTogether Program and associated tariff, Rate Schedule STR, which is the same tariff attached as Attachment I to the Settlement Agreement filed October 9, 2019?
<u>FIPUG:</u>	Adopt position of OPC.
<u>ISSUE 5</u> :	What adjustments, if any, should the Commission make to any affiliate transaction costs associated with FPL's Solar Together Rider tariff?
