Re: Duke Energy Florida Revised Fuel Emergency Plan (filed on January 6, 2020)

Dear Mr. Bernier:

Pursuant to Rule 25-6.0185, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), electric utilities that own or control electric generation facilities are required to file a long-term energy emergency plan and periodic updates with both the Commission and the Florida Reliability Coordinating Council. The utilities are required to review their plans every three calendar years and either submit a revised plan for our approval or provide a letter indicating the adequacy of the existing plan.

Duke Energy Florida (DEF) filed a revised Fuel Emergency Plan on January 6, 2020, Document No. 00066-2020. Commission staff has reviewed DEF's filings and believes the plan establishes proper procedure consistent with Rule 25-6.0185 F.A.C., and the revised plan is hereby administratively approved. Staff requests that DEF notify the Commission of any changes to the Fuel Emergency Plan as filed.
