1	PROCEEDINGS
2	CHAIRMAN CLARK: All right. Items 1, 4, 6, 9,
3	and 11 we're going to take those up beginning
4	with Item No. 1.
5	MR. FOGLEMAN: Good morning, Commissioners.
6	Greg Fogleman for Commission staff.
7	At this time, I'd like to introduce Margarita
8	de Ayala. She's been with the Commission for eight
9	months now. And this will be her first agenda
10	conference.
11	CHAIRMAN CLARK: Thank you.
12	Welcome.
13	MS. HELTON: Mr. Chairman, I'm so sorry to
14	interrupt, but I did not hear you say whether Item
15	No. 10 was approved on the move staff list or
16	whether we were going to take up Item No. 10
17	individually.
18	CHAIRMAN CLARK: Item No. 10 is on the move
19	staff list.
20	MS. HELTON: So, that was included in the
21	items
22	CHAIRMAN CLARK: Yes.
23	MS. HELTON: that Commissioner Brown
24	CHAIRMAN CLARK: Items 2, 3, 7, 8, 10, and 12.
25	MS. HELTON: Okay. Thank you.

1	MS. de AYALA: Good morning, Commissioners,
2	Margarita de Ayala on behalf of IDM staff.
3	Item No. 1 addresses application for
4	certificate of authority to provide
5	telecommunications service in the state of Florida
6	for JEA. Staff has reviewed the managerial,
7	technical, and financial capabilities and
8	determined that they have met the criteria in
9	accordance with Florida Statutes 364.335;
10	therefore, staff is recommending that JEA
11	application be approved.
12	Staff is available for any questions. And a
13	representative from JEA is available as well.
14	Thank you.
15	CHAIRMAN CLARK: All right. Thank you very
16	much.
17	Commissioners, any questions?
18	Commissioner Brown.
19	COMMISSIONER BROWN: Thank you.
20	I would love to hear from a representative of
21	JEA. If they could come up to the table, please.
22	So, Commissioners, there is a statute that has
23	been disseminated to you that was not referenced in
24	the staff summary on this item. This is
25	interesting because we have a government entity

1	asking to provide communication services in an area
2	that may or may not likely have services already
3	available for which it is applying.
4	Under the statute, which I haven't I
5	haven't seen a case like this since I've been here,
6	but it's communication services offered by
7	governmental entities.
8	Under the statute, 350.81 Subsection 2A, there
9	are requirements that and "B" there are
10	requirements that the governmental entity shall do.
11	And part of that I'd love to hear from JEA about
12	how they intend to comply with these guidelines.
13	CHAIRMAN CLARK: Okay. JEA.
14	MS. CLARK: Commissioner Brown, the first we
15	heard of these questions coming up was last night,
16	about I guess about 6:15. And we had no
17	information about the particulars of what you had
18	asked. I'll do my best.
19	COMMISSIONER BROWN: Okay.
20	MS. CLARK: We haven't necessarily looked at
21	this. This is not
22	COMMISSIONER BROWN: Would you like to see a
23	copy of the statute?
24	MS. CLARK: Sure.
25	COMMISSIONER BROWN: It's very specific and it

1	does just provide what JEA intends to do. I would
2	reference you to 2A and 2B. It references public
3	hearings. It does also reference including the
4	Commission in noticing and things of that nature,
5	so
6	MS. CLARK: Let me just start by introducing
7	myself.
8	CHAIRMAN CLARK: Thank you.
9	MS. CLARK: I'm Susan Clark. I'm with the
10	Radey Law Firm. With me is Tom Crabb, who is also
11	with the lady Radey Law Firm, and we're here on
12	behalf of JEA.
13	There are a couple of things that I would like
14	to point out, and then I'll turn to Tom, in case he
15	has something to add. First of all, it's not the
16	City of Jacksonville who is offering the service;
17	it is JEA, which is separate and is the utility.
18	At this point, they are not planning to engage
19	in telecommunications services to end users. That
20	is not their purpose in this. And, in fact, it's
21	my understanding that there may they may need to
22	have their charter revised.
23	So, I don't know that, even if there is a
24	statute that deals with the municipalities, that it
25	would apply in this instance.

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2	COMMISSIONER BROWN: Why is a certificate,
3	then, being sought?
4	MS. CLARK: A certificate is being sought
5	because, in order for them to attach to poles of
6	other entities, they very often will require them
7	to have a certificate from the Commission.
8	And it's my understanding that this is not
9	different from the Orlando Utilities Commission,
10	that has a certificate as well, and has had one for
11	a while.
12	And in talking to your staff
13	COMMISSIONER BROWN: my time
14	MS. CLARK: There are other municipalities to
15	which these certificates have been granted.
16	COMMISSIONER BROWN: So, if you look at the
17	statute, it does provide a very proscriptive
18	nature, if you intend to seek a certificate for
19	communication services. So, I just want to make
20	sure that the utility is going to comply with all
21	of those requirements.
22	MS. CLARK: Commissioner, I have no reason to
23	believe they will not, and we will certainly carry
24	that message back to them.
25	COMMISSIONER BROWN: Thank you.

1	CHAIRMAN CLARK: Commissioner Graham.
2	COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: No.
3	CHAIRMAN CLARK: Sorry.
4	All right. Any other discussion? Any other
5	questions? I will entertain a motion.
6	COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Move staff.
7	COMMISSIONER FAY: Second.
8	CHAIRMAN CLARK: Motion and second to approve
9	the item as presented. Is there any discussion?
10	All in favor, say aye.
11	(Chorus of ayes.)
12	CHAIRMAN CLARK: Opposed?
13	The item is approved.
14	Thank you very much.
15	MS. CLARK: Thank you, Commissioners.
16	(Agenda item concluded.)
