**Re: Docket No. 20190125-WS - Application for staff-assisted rate case in Sumter County by The Woods Utility Company.**

Dear Ms. Hodgson:

The purpose of this letter is to determine the intent of your email received by the Office of Commission Clerk on April 15, 2020, which objected to the Order approving rate increase for The Woods Utility Company. Specifically, I need to know whether you only wish to state that you object to the approved rate increase, or whether you are also requesting an administrative hearing on the matter.

An administrative hearing is similar to a trial, in which you, the Utility, Commission staff, and any other intervening parties will present testimony and evidence to the Commissioners about whether the Commission-approved rate increase should be affirmed. The hearing process will involve the development of issues, and both issuing and responding to discovery, such as interrogatories, requests for production, and deposition of witnesses. Although the Commission allows individuals to represent themselves, it may be to your benefit to hire an attorney if you intend to pursue this matter to hearing. You may also wish to consult with the Office of Public Counsel, which is a separate Legislative agency, statutorily authorized to represent utility customers in proceedings before the Commission. You can reach the Office of Public Counsel at (850) 488-9330. Please be aware that if you elect not to pursue the matter to hearing at this time, there will not be a later opportunity to do so.

If instead you wish to advise the Commission as to your objection without requesting a hearing, your letter will remain in the correspondence side of the docket file, where it is currently available for the Commission's consideration and for all to review.


