- ISSUE 1: Should the Commission approve withdrawals from the decommissioning trust fund, consistent with the proposed transaction, to pay Accelerated Decommissioning Partners (ADP), via its subsidiary ADP CR3, LLC, and Duke Energy Florida, LLC (DEF) for completing all decommissioning activities at the Crystal River 3 (CR3) nuclear power plant?
- ISSUE 2: Is DEF's proposed transaction with ADP and its subsidiaries for decommissioning CR3 consistent with DEF's 2017 2<sup>nd</sup> Revised and Restated Stipulation and Settlement Agreement (2017 Settlement)?
