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1	PROCEEDINGS
2	CHAIRMAN CLARK: Item No. 12, Mr. Futrell.
3	MR. FUTRELL: Item 12 is staff's
4	recommendation on Duke Energy Florida's petition
5	for approval of its of revisions to its
6	underground residential distribution tariffs.
7	These tariffs apply to new residential
8	subdivisions and represent the additional costs, if
9	any, Duke incurs to provide underground
10	distribution service in place of overhead service.
11	Duke's proposed underground cost differentials
12	remain zero dollars per lot for the load density
13	and gained meter subdivisions. For the high
14	density subdivision, the proposed differential
15	decrease from the current \$34 to zero dollars per
16	lot.
17	The decrease in the differentials is primarily
18	attributable to changes in Duke's labor, material
19	and operational costs.
20	In addition, Duke is proposing two additional
21	undergrounding cost options in its tariffs, these
22	changes would allow developers the option to
23	purchase and install primary and secondary conduit
24	in the subdivision.
25	Mr. David, with the Office of Public Counsel,

1	would like to address the Commission, and
2	representatives of the utility are available to
3	reply to his comments in and your questions.
4	CHAIRMAN CLARK: All right. Mr. David, you
5	are recognized.
6	MR DAVID: Yes, sir. This is Tad David for
7	the Office of Public Counsel, appearing on behalf
8	of J.R. Kelly and the citizens of the State of
9	Florida.
10	I would request the comments I am making made
11	part of the record of both Docket 20200110, which
12	is the Duke docket, and and also Docket
13	20200113, which is Item 13, the Gulf docket. And I
14	was just I was just going to make the comment
15	one time, and then request that they be inserted
16	into the records of each of those dockets so that I
17	didn't I was not redundant in any commentary
18	unnecessarily.
19	I am not here also to oppose Duke's or Gulf's
20	request, or staff's recommendation necessarily in
21	these dockets. However, OPC wants to ensure that
22	Duke's and Gulf's customers do not pay for
23	undergrounding which these utilities were otherwise
24	compensated.
25	I would like assurances that the rates charged

for Duke's or Gulf's proposed revisions to their
residential -- residential tariffs not only -excuse me, are not also included in any request for
recovery under the Storm Protection Plan Cost
Recovery Clause.

Further, since the rule expressly requires the cost estimate to reflect the requirements of 25-6.0342 the Florida Administrative Code for the storm hardening, that that rule has been repealed in light of the adoption of the storm protection plan rules. I would request the Commission consider all costs these companies might recover through the SPP mechanism under Section 366.96 Florida Statutes, and Rules 25-6.030 and 25-6.031 of the Florida Administrative Code, and request this recovery be reflected in any charge under any of the proposed tariffs in these dockets.

At a minimum, OPC requests that the

Commission, in approving any change under the URD

tariff in these dockets -- proposed in either

docket, expressly include a requirement that the

company verify in writing that any project paid

through the URD tariff would not also be included

in any program in the can company's SPPs or

requests recovery under the SPP CR3. We would

1	request that that requirement be explicitly
2	included in the order in each of these dockets.
3	This can be done by requiring a report within
4	30 days of the Commission's approval of any
5	recovery requested through the SPP CR3, with such
б	report clearly demonstrating that no project paid
7	through the URD tariff is or will be included in
8	any of the program in the company's SPPs or request
9	for recovery under its SPP.
10	This will simply ensure that the spirit of
11	Rule 25-6.078, and Section 366.96(8) of Florida
12	Statutes will be upheld and will provide protection
13	to Duke's and Gulf's customers, and assure that
14	there will not be a double recovery either under
15	either the SPP CR3 or the URD tariffs proposed
16	herein.
17	Thank you for the time this morning or this
18	afternoon now, and I am here for any questions that
19	the Commissioners may have.
20	CHAIRMAN CLARK: Thank you.
21	MR. FUTRELL: Mr. Chairman, if I may, I am
22	sorry
23	CHAIRMAN CLARK: Mr. Futrell.
24	MR. FUTRELL: but we were not the staff
25	was not aware that Mr. David's comments went to

1	both Items 12 and 13. So perhaps if you if you
2	wish to to take these up simultaneously, since
3	his comments went to both dockets, that way that
4	will give both companies an opportunity to respond,
5	and for the Commission to entertain both at the
6	same time.
7	CHAIRMAN CLARK: Yeah, I have no objection.
8	Any of Commissioner object?
9	We have no objections from the Commissioners.
10	Ms. Helton, is that good with you?
11	MS. HELTON: Mr. Futrell checked with me
12	first, and I am all good.
13	CHAIRMAN CLARK: All right. We are going to
14	take both of these items up simultaneously to keep
15	Mr. David from having to repeat his comments again.
16	MR. DAVID: Thank you.
17	CHAIRMAN CLARK: All right. First of all, Mr.
18	Bernier, any response?
19	MR. BERNIER: Just very briefly, Mr. Chairman.
20	I I will verify right now on the record
21	that Duke Energy will not be double recovering any
22	costs through SPP and through the URD. That's our
23	intention, and we take appropriate steps to make
24	sure that that does not occur.
25	CHAIRMAN CLARK: Thank you very much.

1	Mr. Badders, can you swear and affirm the
2	same?
3	MR. RUBIN: Thank you, Mr. Chairman, this is
4	Ken Rubin. I am appearing on behalf of Gulf.
5	Certainly, we will not be double recovering,
6	or seek to make any kind of double recovery. This
7	is the first we have heard of Public Counsel's
8	additional requests, which were not part of the
9	staff recommendation, were not part of the docket,
10	and so I was a little bit taken aback by the
11	comments, but we fully support the staff
12	recommendation and would oppose any additional
13	conditions that Public Counsel had suggested.
14	Thank you, sir.
15	CHAIRMAN CLARK: Thank you Mr. Rubin.
16	All right. Commissioners, any questions?
17	Commissioner Graham?
18	COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Yes, Mr. Chairman.
19	I move staff recommendation on Items 12 and
20	13.
21	CHAIRMAN CLARK: Can I have a second?
22	COMMISSIONER BROWN: Second.
23	CHAIRMAN CLARK: I have a motion and a second
24	to approve Items 12 and 13, staff recommendation.
25	Any discussion on any of the items?

1	Commissioner Fay, I am sorry, your green light
2	came on. You are good? Okay. It was on for half
3	a second.
4	All right. Any any other Commissioner, any
5	comments?
6	All right. On the motion, all in favor, say
7	aye.
8	(Chorus of ayes.)
9	CHAIRMAN CLARK: Opposed?
10	(No response.)
11	CHAIRMAN CLARK: The motion is approved.
