RE: Administrative Closure, Docket No. 20200177-SU - Application for amendment of Cert 517-S to delete territory in Polk County, by Crooked Lake Park Sewerage Company.

On July 2, 2020, Crooked Lake Park Sewerage Company (Crooked Lake) filed its application to amend its wastewater certificate in Polk County to delete territory. During the pendency of the proceeding, Crooked Lake made the business decision to abandon the utility. Crooked Lake submitted a Notice of Abandonment on September 4, 2020. Docket No. 20200210-SU was opened to address the abandonment proceedings. Thus, Crooked Lake no longer needs to amend its certificate.

Also, on September 4, 2020, Crooked Lake filed a request that its application filed in Docket No. 20200177-SU be withdrawn. On September 11, 2020, it filed a notice stating it was not seeking a refund of its filing fee. Staff has determined that there are no pending issues that need to be addressed by the Commission regarding the filing. Pursuant to Section 2.07 C.2.d(4), of the Administrative Procedures Manual, staff may administratively close dockets in which the applicant seeks to withdraw its initial pleading, there are no pending issues that need to be addressed by the Commission, and no request for refund of the filing fee has been made. Therefore, the Division of Engineering and the Office of General Counsel request that Docket No. 20200177-SU be closed administratively.
