I am communicating my concerns regarding the referenced docket number up for approval. The proposal on the table is for providing for a small portion of the power grid in Florida to be moved from overhead to underground locations. I believe that the current procedure that is in place for the approval of said grid improvements is seriously lacking in planning, oversight and transparency. The vast amount of money required to provide these improvements is not acceptable to the public. We are talking about 40 billion dollars between now and 2059- with the utilities pocketing 12 billion in profits.
