2	CHAIRMAN CLARK: Let's move to Item No. 5.
3	Mr. Stiller, you are still up.
4	MR. STILLER: Thank you, Mr. Chair.
5	Item 5 involves the staff recommendation that
6	the Commission reconsider, on its own motion, a
7	prior order in this docket that allowed Peoples Gas
8	System to establish a regulatory asset to record
9	costs incurred due to COVID-19.
10	Like the prior agenda item, this order was
11	entered as a final order, not proposed agency
12	action, or PAA. On the same basis as discussed
13	with respect to Agenda Item 4, staff believes that
14	the order should have been entered as a PAA.
15	Again, the appropriate relief for this item is
16	to vacate a prior order and render it as PAA.
17	Staff is available for questions.
18	CHAIRMAN CLARK: Thank you, Mr. Stiller.
19	Ms. Fall-Fry and Mr. Brown, I believe are
20	or Ms. Fall-Fry has requested to make comments.
21	Ms. Fall-Fry, are you on the line?
22	MS. FALL-FRY: I am here. Can you hear me?
23	CHAIRMAN CLARK: Yes, we can.
24	MS. FALL-FRY: Okay. This is A. Mireille
25	Fall-Fry for the Office of Public Counsel, along

1	with J.R. Kelly, the Public Counsel.
2	I just want to thank staff for and the support
3	of the recommendation and appreciate the integrity
4	that's required to admit the error in its prior
5	recommendation to this Commission.
6	Furthermore, to answer Commissioner Brown's
7	previous question, and Commissioner Fay's previous
8	question, in this item before the Commission at
9	Agenda, I specifically noted the prior regulatory
10	asset case cases and how they went forward, and
11	specifically requested that the Commission issue a
12	PAA on this item. So we appreciate that the
13	Commission is getting ready to do that, it appears,
14	on its own motion, and I thank you for the
15	consideration.
16	CHAIRMAN CLARK: Thank you very much.
17	Mr. Brown, any comments?
18	MR. BROWN: No, sir.
19	CHAIRMAN CLARK: Thank you.
20	Commissioners, questions?
21	Commissioner Brown.
22	COMMISSIONER BROWN: I have a question similar
23	to the one in the last docket, regarding
24	appealing my understanding is you have filed an
25	official appeal on this matter, and with the rate

1	case being so close to the current to this point
2	of entry here, is it your objective to have two
3	separate hearings?
4	MS. FALL-FRY: Yes.
5	COMMISSIONER BROWN: Pardon me, one quick
6	MS. FALL-FRY: The entry of a regulatory
7	asset I am sorry, can you hear me?
8	COMMISSIONER BROWN: Yes.
9	MS. FALL-FRY: The we OPC's position is
10	that regulatory assets are a two-step process.
11	There is the entry of the regulatory the
12	approval of the regulatory asset itself, which is a
13	substantive matter, and then there is the recovery
14	of costs itself, which is no different than when we
15	have hurricane storm recoveries, or any other
16	matter where there is the accounting mechanism
17	which has to be approved by the Commission, and OPC
18	believes it's a substantive issue that requires a
19	hearing, and then there is the actual costs which
20	can be wrapped into a rate case.
21	In PGS's case, there we are currently in a
22	rate case, so that may not happen specifically with
23	PGS. But with the other companies who have not yet
24	filed their rate cases, it will probably line up
25	better to do to combine the recovery with the

1	rate cases. But either way, however it works out,
2	we would like two hearings.
3	COMMISSIONER BROWN: Thank you. I just wanted
4	some clarification on that to see whether we the
5	establishment of a regulatory asset could also be
6	handled in the rate case proceeding rather than two
7	separate proceedings.
8	CHAIRMAN CLARK: Other questions?
9	All right. I will entertain a motion.
10	COMMISSIONER FAY: Mr. Chairman, I will move
11	staff's recommendation on all issues.
12	CHAIRMAN CLARK: Do I have a second?
13	COMMISSIONER BROWN: Second.
14	CHAIRMAN CLARK: I have a motion and a second
15	to approve staff recommendation on all issues.
16	Any discussion?
17	On the motion, all in favor say aye.

19	CHAIRMAN CLARK: Opposed?
