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1 PROCEEDINGS 2 CHAIRMAN CLARK: Item No. 8, Mr. Futrell. 3 MR. FUTRELL: Item 8 is the joint motion to 4 approve a settlement agreement for Duke Energy Florida in the Storm Protection Plan Cost Recovery 5 Clause. 6 7 On October 10th, 2020, the Commission approved 8 DEF's storm protection plan pursuant to a settlement in Docket No. 20200069-EI. On September 9 10 1st, 2020, the Commission held a hearing that 11 considered two Duke settlements pertaining to the 12 Storm Protection Plan Cost Recovery Clause. At 13 hearing, the Commission approved the settlement

14 agreement for Duke that established the types of 15 costs that would be recovered through the clause. 16 The parties were permitted to file post-hearing 17 briefs by September 11th addressing the remaining 18 settlement agreement.

19The settlement agreement before you today20would approve specific costs to be recovered21through the clause -- through the clause by Duke22during 2021.

23 Staff believes the settlement is now ripe for
24 Commission vote.
