Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Peoples Gas System (PGS or Company) requests confidential classification for certain highlighted responses to Staff's 10th Set of Interrogatories (Nos. 90 and 91).

The Company is claiming confidentiality for certain highlighted information appearing in Document No. 11338-2020 under Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S. Per the Statute, propriety of confidential business information includes, but is not limited to: Subsection (e) "Information relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of information." The information provided in Document No. 11338-2020 for which confidential treatment is being sought includes commercially sensitive confidential information concerning future revenue projections, specific customer information, and internal budgeting figures. Furthermore, PGS maintains that the information provided in Document No. 11338-2020 has not been publicly disclosed.

Staff has reviewed the information provided in the highlighted portions of the Company's response to staff's 10th set of interrogatories (Nos. 90 and 91), as well as the Company's confidentiality request (Document No. 11277-2020). In staff's opinion, the information that is the subject of the confidentiality request does meet the criteria for confidentiality contained in Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S. Therefore, staff recommends that the request for confidentiality of information included in Document No. 11338-2020 be approved.
