On October 16, 2020 Peoples Gas System (PGS) filed a second revised request for confidential treatment for Document No. 11334-2020 in Document No. 11275-2020. This document consists of responses to Peoples Responses to Staff's Ninth Interrogatory Request No. 88.

In its request for confidentiality, PGS asserts that disclosure of this information would cause harm to Peoples business operations and its customers and disclosure of the information would cause harm to the company's business operations. PGS asserts that disclosure of such information would impair the competitive business of the provider of information.

Staff has reviewed the document and concurs with PGS that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would impair the competitive business operations of PGS. Therefore, staff recommends that the request by PGS for confidential classification be approved.
