I am writing as a concerned Florida resident and customer of Florida Power & Light (FPL). I received notification that FPL intends to increase rates for customers like me. I am urging you to rethink this decision and not increase our bills.

This past year has been extremely challenging financially for many people in the state of Florida. A rate increase is the last thing we need, especially for vulnerable folks who may be on a fixed income or struggling to find work.

My bill went from 344\$ in February last year, to 688\$ this February. This is ridiculous! I have 3 small children and now have to choose to give them heat and air or food, this isn't right, and so unfair to our residents. How is this ok? How is it ok for this to be done to us?? I will move out of Florida and urge everyone I know to do the same before I pay these ridiculous prices.

I urge you to reconsider, and help us, help the residents of your community, before we have a double number of homeless families and children, because of a greedy corporation that

would rather see children starve and go without heat/air and lights so they can fill there greedy pockets!
