## Commissioners,

Good Morning. We have a vacation property at 8720 Little Gasparilla Island. I personally was not able to attend the hearings for wastewater service, which would include LGI, but I know many of the property owners that did attend. After watching the proceedings on line, I am now even more opposed to the installation of sewer lines on the island as I ever was.

Our place is a weekend home. We do not rent to outsiders, and maybe are down on the island once a month. Many other homes are similar to us - very low usage. To shoulder us with this great individual expense is just not right, especially when the whole concept is being driven by a for-profit entity, with no previous input from islanders. We did not ask for this. If there is a sewage problem with individual septic systems, use the rules already in place for enforcement. Don't assume there is a problem with the entire proposed service area.

Island residents are well aware of Mr. Boyer's lack of technical expertise. Many question his financial ability to cover such a large project. What happens to us if he fails? Who will bail us out, Charlotte County? The cost of the hookup and associated out-of-pocket expenses will drive us off the island. Our house has been in the family since 1995. We cannot replace that.
