On March 29, 2022, pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Duke Energy Florida (DEF or Company) requested an extension of confidential classification for information contained in documents produced in response to Staff's 8th Request for Production of Documents (Nos. 25-26). Specifically, the material that is the subject of this confidentiality request appears in Document No. 03445-2020 as Bates Nos. DEF RESP STAFF 8TH POD - 000434 through DEF RESP STAFF 8TH POD – 000443.

On June 30, 2020, DEF filed the original Request for Confidential Classification related to this document. DEF's Request was granted by Order No. PSC-2020-0353-CFO-EI on October 9, 2020.

The Company is claiming confidentiality for highlighted information appearing in Document No. 03445-2020 under Section 366.093(3)(d) and (e), F.S. Per the Statute, propriety of confidential business information includes, but is not limited to: Subsection (d) "Information concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the public utility or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms," and subsection (e) "Information relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of information." Information provided in Document No. 03445-2020 for which confidential treatment is being sought includes sensitive confidential information concerning contractual business information and obligations under a contract between DEF, ADP CR3, LLC and ADP SF1, LLC for decommissioning activities related to the accelerated decommissioning of the DEF Crystal River Unit 3 Nuclear Plant. Furthermore, DEF maintains that the information provided in Document No. 03445-2020 has not been publicly disclosed.

Staff has reviewed the information contained in the documents produced by DEF, as well as the Company's confidentiality request. In staff's opinion, the information that is the subject of the confidentiality request does meet the criteria for confidentiality contained in Section 366.093(3)(d) and (e), F.S. Therefore, staff recommends that the request for extension of confidentiality of certain information included in Document No. 03445-2020 be approved.
