I don't agree with this approved monthly minimum base bill of \$25.00 which went into effect in June 2022. I am a seasonal resident and my monthly bill from June-Dec. used to be from \$9.00 to \$15.00 as I only have the A/C running. Starting in June 2022, my monthly bill has been more than \$27.00. I feel that this new base bill of \$25.00/month is unfair and discriminates against seasonal residents. Most of us that are seasonal are on fixed income and we don't need these extra expenses added to our monthly bill. The permanent residents would not incur any additional costs to their monthly statements. This increase in the minimum base bill is "intended to help cover the fixed costs of operating the electric grid."
