JOINT REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

Peoples Gas System ("Peoples" or "the company") and Florida Public Utilities Company ("FPUC"), (collectively, "the Parties"), pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, hereby requests confidential classification for information contained in Exhibit A, the proposed Gas Transportation Agreement (the "Special Contract"), to its Joint Petition for Approval of Special Contract which is submitted for filing concurrently herewith. In support thereof, the Parties state:

- 1. Peoples and FPUC seek confidential classification of the highlighted rates and terms ("Confidential Information") in the Special Contract, which represent contractual information that both Parties treat as proprietary confidential business information consistent with the definition of that term in Section 366.093, Florida Statutes.
- 2. Subsection 366.093(1), Florida Statutes, provides that any records "found by the Commission to be proprietary confidential business information shall be kept confidential and shall be exempt from s.119.07(1) [requiring disclosure under the Public Records Act]." The proprietary confidential business information includes, but is not limited to:
 - (d) Information concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the public utility or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms. (Section 366.093(3)(d), Florida Statutes)
 - 3. Proprietary confidential business information also includes:
 - (e) Information relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the

provider of the information. (Section 366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes)

4. The Confidential Information falls within the above statutory categories and, thus,

constitutes proprietary confidential business information entitled to protection under Section

366.093 and Rule 25-22.006. The Confidential Information within the Special Contract includes

a monthly rate and usage charge associated with the reservation of firm capacity (at Bates Stamp

page 5 of Exhibit A) and a daily volume rate (at Bates Stamp page 10 of Exhibit A). As such, the

information in question is information concerning bids or other contractual data the disclosure of

which would impair the efforts of Peoples and FPUC to contract for goods and services on

favorable terms. It is also information relating to competitive interests the disclosure of which

would impair the competitive business of Peoples and FPUC.

5. Peoples and FPUC treat the Confidential Information as such and have not

disclosed it publicly.

WHEREFORE, Peoples and FPUC respectfully request that the highlighted Confidential

Information contained in the Special Contract, at Bates Stamp pages 5 and 10 of Exhibit A, be

afforded confidential classification for the reasons set forth above.
