My bill for April of 2022 actually had a credit for March and April and dropped at least \$30.00. Then the very next month people on social media were questioning if other's bills had jumped by \$150.00! Mine did not jump that much in one month,, but has increased roughly \$50.00 a month since, despite having a new A/C system and keeping it set on 75 degrees at all times even in this extremely hot summer; and for 2 months having 1 less person in the home, doing less laundry, cooking, showers, etc.
