St. Joe Natural Gas Company, Inc. ("SJNG") by and through its undersigned officer, hereby submits its Prehearing Statements for the hearing scheduled to commence in the proceeding November 1, 2022.

C. <u>Statement of Basic Position:</u>

The Commission should approve the final adjusted net true-up amount for the twelve- month period ending December 31, 2022 including interest, the projected conservation program expenses for the twelve-month period ending Dec 31, 2023 and the Conservation Cost Recovery Factors to be applied to customer bills rendered for the twelve-month period ending December 31, 2023 as filed by SJNG.

D. <u>SJNG's position on each issue:</u>

ISSUE 1. What are the final conservation cost recovery adjustment true-up amounts for the period January **2021** through December **2021**?

SJNG: An over-recovery of \$23,184.

ISSUE 2. What are the appropriate conservation adjustment actual/estimated true-up amounts for the period January through December **2022**?

SJNG: Conservation adjustment actual/estimated true-up is \$56,534 over-recovery.

ISSUE 3. What are the appropriate total conservation adjustment true-up amounts to be collected/refunded from January through December **2023**?

SJNG: The total conservation adjustment true-up amount to be refunded is \$79,718 over-recovery.

ISSUE 4. What is the total conservation cost recovery adjustment true-up amounts to be collected during the January through December **2023** period.

SJNG: The true-up amount to be collected is \$114,907 under-recovery.

ISSUE 5. What are the conservation cost recovery factors for the period January **2023** through December **2023**?

SJNG: The appropriate factors are:

RATE CLASS	RATE/\$PER THERM
RS-1	\$0.27254
RS-2	\$0.19097
RS-3	\$0.14851
GS-1	\$0.09512
GS-2	\$0.05337
GS-4/TS-4	\$0.04049

ISSUE 6. Should the Commission approve revised tariffs reflecting the natural gas conservation cost recovery amounts and establishing natural gas conservation cost recovery factors determined to be appropriate in this proceeding?

SJNG: Yes. The Commission should approve revised tariffs reflecting the new Conservation Cost Recovery charges determined to be appropriate in the proceeding.

ISSUE 7. What should be the effective date of the new conservation cost recovery factors for billing purposes?

SJNG: The effective date should be January 1, 2023.

ISSUE 8: Should this docket be closed?

SJNG: Yes please
