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1	PROCEEDINGS
2	COMMISSIONER LA ROSA: Let's move to the 04
3	docket. I think that's back at you, Mr. Jones.
4	You are recognized for any preliminary matters that
5	need to be addressed before the draft prehearing
6	order.
7	MR. JONES: Yes, sir.
8	We have Type 2 stipulations that are pending
9	in this docket. Those have not been finalized as
10	of today.
11	And additionally, staff is awaiting
12	confirmation from all parties that they are
13	amenable to excusing witnesses.
14	COMMISSIONER LA ROSA: Excellent.
15	Does any other parties have any other
16	preliminary matters?
17	Seeing none, similar, as I was just done in
18	the last two, I will run through these pretty
19	quickly. So please jump you have up if you have
20	got something and I will certainly recognize you.
21	Section I, Case Background. Seeing none.
22	Section II, Conduct in Proceedings.
23	Section III, Jurisdiction.
24	Section IV, Procedure for Handling
25	Confidential Information.

1	Section V, Prefiled Testimony and Exhibits and
2	Witnesses.
3	MR. JONES: Staff suggests that for any
4	witness who is not excused that the summary of
5	their testimony be no longer than three minutes.
6	COMMISSIONER LA ROSA: Sounds good. Parties,
7	are we all in agreement? I don't see any
8	objections.
9	Let's move on to the order of witnesses.
10	MR. JONES: If stipulation of issues and
11	witness testimony can be reached, staff will
12	confirm with each Commissioner whether such witness
13	can be excused. If no Commissioner has a question
14	of a stipulated witness, the witness may be excused
15	from the hearing and his or her testimony and
16	exhibits entered into the record as though read.
17	COMMISSIONER LA ROSA: Okay. Excellent.
18	Section VII, Basic Positions. Do the parties
19	have any changes to their basic positions? Okay.
20	If there are any please do so in writing before the
21	close of business tomorrow.
22	Section VIII, Issues and Positions. Parties,
23	are there any related matters that need to be
24	discussed?
25	MR. JONES: For that, staff will note that for

1	issues in which a party has taken no position at
2	this time, if a party does not take a position on
3	these issues, per the OEP their position will be
4	changed to no position in the prehearing order.
5	And additionally, per the OEP, if a party
6	fails to take a position on an issue by the time of
7	the prehearing conference, the party waives its
8	opportunity to conduct cross-examination on the
9	issue, as well as file a post-hearing brief on the
10	issue.
11	COMMISSIONER LA ROSA: Okay. Excellent.
12	Let's move on, then, to the exhibit list.
13	MR. JONES: Staff will note that we have
14	prepared and circulated a comprehensive exhibit
15	list that includes all prefiled exhibits, and also
16	includes those exhibits staff wishes to include in
17	the record. Staff will check with the parties
18	prior to the hearing to determine if there are any
19	objections to the comprehensive exhibit list.
20	COMMISSIONER LA ROSA: Excellent.
21	Proposed Stipulations in Section X.
22	MR. JONES: Staff notes that Type 2
23	stipulations are pending in this docket, but those
24	have not been finalized as of today.
25	MS. CHRISTENSEN: Commissioner.

1	COMMISSIONER LA ROSA: Yes, I am sorry, you
2	are recognized.
3	MS. CHRISTENSEN: Thank you, Commissioner.
4	I just noted that in the footnote regarding
5	the Type 2 stipulation, it has part of the language
6	that we normally have related to Type 2
7	stipulations. There is some additional language
8	that we have included regarding representation of
9	OPC's position on Type 2 stipulations that we can
10	provide to staff, or confirm with staff, that gets
11	included in the order. Otherwise, we are in a
12	position to facilitate Type 2 stipulations.
13	COMMISSIONER LA ROSA: Okay. Staff, are you
14	okay with that?
15	MR. JONES: Yes. Staff is happy to work with
16	OPC on the issue.
17	COMMISSIONER LA ROSA: Excellent.
18	All right. Well, then let's move on to
19	pending motions.
20	MR. JONES: There is no pending motions at
21	this time.
22	COMMISSIONER LA ROSA: Okay. Pending
23	confidential confidentiality motions.
24	MR. JONES: There are no pending
25	confidentiality motions at this time.

1	COMMISSIONER LA ROSA: Let's talk about the
2	post-hearing procedures.
3	MR. JONES: If stipulations are reached on all
4	issues, a bench decision may be possible in this
5	docket. However, if there is no bench decision,
6	staff recommends post-hearing briefs be no longer
7	than 40 pages.
8	COMMISSIONER LA ROSA: Okay. That sounds
9	fair. All parties in agreement? Seeing no
10	objections.
11	Let's talk about rulings.
12	MR. JONES: Staff recommends that the
13	Prehearing Officer make a ruling that opening
14	statements, if any, should not exceed three minutes
15	per party unless any party chooses to waive its
16	opening statements.
17	COMMISSIONER LA ROSA: All parties in
18	agreement? Sounds right.
19	Any other matters that need to be addressed in
20	the prehearing conference?
21	MR. JONES: No, sir.
22	COMMISSIONER LA ROSA: Okay. Seeing no other
23	matters, this concludes the prehearing for the 04
24	docket.
