REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

Tampa Electric Company (“Tampa Electric” or “the company”), pursuant to Section 366.093 Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, hereby requests confidential classification for the highlighted information contained in the company’s responses to Staff’s First Data Request.

Description of the Document(s)

On January 12, 2023, Commission Staff served its First Data Request (Nos. 1-6) on Tampa Electric. On February 2, 2023, Tampa Electric filed its responses to this Data Request in the above-captioned docket. The company believes that portions of its responses to Data Request Nos. 1.a and 2.b and the Excel files supporting those answers, as specified on Exhibit “A,” constitute “proprietary confidential business information” and has designated them as such by highlighting. Tampa Electric requests confidential classification for this information such that it will be entitled to protection against public disclosure pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes. In support of this request, the company states:

1. Subsection 366.093(1), Florida Statutes, provides that any records “found by the Commission to be proprietary confidential business information shall be kept confidential and shall be exempt from s. 119.07(1), Florida Statutes [requiring disclosure under the Public Records Act].” Proprietary confidential business information includes but is not limited to: “information concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the public utility or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms” and “information

relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information.”§366.093(3)(d)-(e), Fla. Stat. The confidential information that is the subject of this request falls within these statutory categories and, thus, constitutes proprietary confidential business information entitled to protection under Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code.

2. Attached hereto as Exhibit A is a justification for confidential treatment of the confidential information.

3. The non-confidential, redacted versions of the company’s responses to Staff’s First Data Request were filed in the above-captioned docket on this date and are not included as an attachment hereto.


4. The confidential information in these responses and supporting documents is intended to be and is treated by Tampa Electric as confidential and has not been publicly disclosed.

5. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(9)(a), Tampa Electric requests that the Confidential Information be treated by the Commission as confidential proprietary business information for 18 months.

WHEREFORE, Tampa Electric Company respectfully requests that the Confidential Information that is the subject of this request and motion be accorded confidential classification for the reasons set forth herein for 18 months.

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

This information is accordingly entitled to confidential protection pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code.
