1 PROCEEDINGS 2 CHAIRMAN FAY: Commissioners, next we will 3 move to Item No. 12, which will be presented by Ms. 4 Bruce this morning. 5 Good morning, Commissioners. MS. BRUCE: I am Sonica Bruce speaking on behalf of Commission 6 7 staff. Item No. 12 addresses a limited alternative 8 9 rate increase for the 14 systems located in Hardee, 10 Manatee, Marion, Polk and Pasco Counties as 11 outlined in the recommendation. 12 In accordance to Rule 25-30.457, Florida 13 Administrative Code, staff determined that the 14 utilities met eligibility requirements for a limited rate increase alternative -- limited 15 16 The rule allows an alternative rate increase. 17 eligible utility to apply for an increase in rates 18 no greater than 20 percent. 19 Staff is recommending percentage increases 20 ranging from five to 20 percent to the system's 21 existing service rates. All customers received a Solicitation of 22 23 Comments Notice, which included a customer comment 24 card that customers could complete and mail to the 25 Commission. To this date, we have received

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1 approximately 70 customer comments regarding 2 quality of service and the rate increase. 3 Utility representative Jeff Small is available 4 to answer any questions, and staff is prepared to 5 answer any questions that you have at this time. 6 CHAIRMAN FAY: Okay. Great. Thank you, Ms. 7 Bruce. Commissioners, any questions on Item 12? 8 9 Showing none, I will take up a motion for Item 10 No. 12. 11 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Move to approve, Mr. 12 Chairman. 13 COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Second. 14 CHAIRMAN FAY: Okay.
