DEFINITIONS

BULK POWER COST (BPC)

Those costs related to the purchase of wholesale power.

BULK POWER COST BASE (BPCB)

The power related cost that is embedded within the base rate, stated in cost per kilowatthour.

BULK POWER COST ADJUSTMENT (BPCA)

The difference between the adjusted bulk power unit cost and the bulk power cost base, stated in cost kilowatt-hour, as determined by calculation.

BULK POWER COST TRUE-UP (BPCT)

The difference between the bulk power cost actually incurred and the bulk power cost recovered through the bulk power cost base and the bulk power cost adjustment.

RATE STABILIZATION FUND ADJUSTMENT (RFSA)

All extraordinary power cost adjustments, other than routine wholesale true-ups, will be deposited into or withdrawn from a Rate Stabilization Fund to be used at the Town's discretion to offset sudden and temporary changes in the cost of power or for other lawful purposes. Inclusion of a RSFA in the monthly BPCA calculation is intended to limit fluctuations in the BPCA.

Bulk Power Cost Rate Structure Change

Manager Summary:

The Town of Havana currently charges \$0.0919 per kWh as a base energy charge (+/-) any fuel adjustment and the customer distribution access charge. Of the \$0.0919 per kWh base energy charge, we have been allocating our bulk power cost base at \$0.0540. In layman's terms, this means that our base rate only covers the first \$54 per MWh of power cost, with the rest recovered through the fuel adjustment.

FMPA's All-In Rate and Cost Projections through FY2024 project Bulk Power Costs ranging from \$0.098 per kWh to \$0.069 per kWh, with an average nearing \$0.080 per kWh.

Havana's true bulk power cost is closer to \$0.080 per kWh. We have been making up the cost in our Fuel Adjustment which has caused it to increase to meet the cost of power.

FMPA's legal counsel, Jody Finklea, will discuss this issue in greater detail.

I am requesting that we increase our bulk power cost base to \$0.080 per kWh, so that we can decrease our fuel adjustment accordingly. With that bulk power cost base, we will also need to increase our base energy charge by the difference between the prior (\$0.0540 per kWh) and proposed (\$0.080 per kWh) bulk power cost base, or \$0.026 per kWh. This results in a new base energy charge of \$0.1179 per kWh. This adjustment will not eliminate the fuel adjustment, which will still fluctuate based on the cost of natural gas and other factors impacting bulk power costs. This revenue neutral adjustment better aligns base energy charges with reality as it relates to the expected prevailing cost of bulk power supply.

Please note – any revisions to our rate tariff, including this one, must be filed with the Florida Public Service Commission.

Whereas, the Havana Town Council hereby adopts a twenty eight percent increase in the TOWN OF HAVANA electric base rate.

Whereas, the increase in the electric base rate will be offset by a decrease in the fuel adjustment charge so that more of the electric utility's wholesale power costs are collected by the base rate.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Havana Town Council approves increasing the electric rate 28 percent and the corresponding reduction in the fuel adjustment charge.

Resolution introduced and adopted this <u>27th</u> day of <u>June</u> 2023 at a Regular Council Meeting for the Town Council of Town of Havana, Florida. Rates to be effective within 30 days after filing with the Public Service Commission.
