Grab your seats. 5 All right. This is the virtual customer service hearing for Peoples Gas, Incorporated case, 6 7 today's hearing is an important part of the rate 8 case process, and the idea is to hear directly from 9 the customers. 10 I am Andrew Fay. I am the Chair of the Public 11 Service Commission. I have with me my colleagues, 12 both in person and on the phone today, Commissioner 13 Graham, Commissioner Clark, Commissioner La Rosa 14 and Commissioner Passidomo. Just last, before we go into any 17 closing remarks and adjourn, I want to make sure 18 once again there are no customers currently on the 19 line for the Peoples Gas System customer meeting. 20 All right.
