1 P R O C E E D I N G S

2 CHAIRMAN FAY: All right. Next we will move  
3 to Item No. 6 this morning, which will be presented  
4 by Ms. Norris when you are ready.

5 MS. NORRIS: Good morning. Amber Norris with  
6 Commission staff.

7 Item 6 is staff's recommendation on Florida  
8 Power & Light Company's request for approval to  
9 implement an amended interim storm restoration  
10 recovery charge.

11 On September 5th, 2023, FPL filed a  
12 supplemental petition to reduce the interim storm  
13 surcharge based on its internal review and  
14 finalization of the invoices and storm costs  
15 associated with Hurricanes Ian and Nicole. As a  
16 result of this internal process, the estimated  
17 incremental storm restoration costs related to the  
18 two storms decreased from the original estimate of  
19 1.3 billion to 1.1 billion, including replenishment  
20 of the storm's reserve and the remaining costs  
21 associated with Hurricanes Michael, Zeta and Sally,  
22 the total costs decreased from 1.5 billion to 1.3  
23 billion.

24 FPL has proposed reduced interim storm  
25 restoration charges applicable to all rate classes

1 effective with the first billing cycle of January  
2 2024, and continuing through March 2024.

3 The approval of an interim storm restoration  
4 recovery charge is preliminary in nature and is  
5 subject to refund pending a further review once the  
6 total actual storm restoration costs are known.

7 Based on review of the information provided by  
8 FPL in its petition, staff recommends that the  
9 Commission authorize FPL to implement the amended  
10 interim storm restoration recovery charge subject  
11 to refund. Once the total actual storm costs are  
12 known, FPL should be required to file documentation  
13 of the storm costs for Commission's review.

14 The Office of Public Counsel and Walmart have  
15 intervened in this docket.

16 Thank you.

17 CHAIRMAN FAY: Okay. Great. Thank you, Ms.  
18 Norris, for the summary on this item. I know it's  
19 a big number, so I appreciate the background.

20 Commissioners, any questions or comments on  
21 Item No. 6?


