Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Tampa Electric Company (TECO or Company) requests confidential classification of certain information contained in Exhibit 1 to its petition, which consists of the proposed contract for the purchase of capacity and associated energy between TECO and Pasco County. TECO requests confidentiality of various responses under Section 366.093(3), subpart (d), F.S., which states: [i]nformation concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the public utility or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms," and subpart (e), F.S., which states: "[i]nformation relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information"

The information provided in Exhibit 1 for which TECO requests confidentiality, pursuant to 366.093(3)(d) and (e), F.S., can be described as contractual payment rates between TECO and Pasco County and contract termination payment values. Staff has reviewed TECO's confidentiality request for Exhibit 1 and determined that disclosure of the confidential information identified could impair TECO's ability to contract for capacity or energy in the future. Therefore, staff recommends that this information meets the criteria for confidential classification pursuant to Section 366.093(3)(d) and (e), F.S.
