ADVANCES FOR CONSTRUCTION - This account shall include advances by or in behalf of customers for construction which are to be refunded either wholly or in part. (USOA)

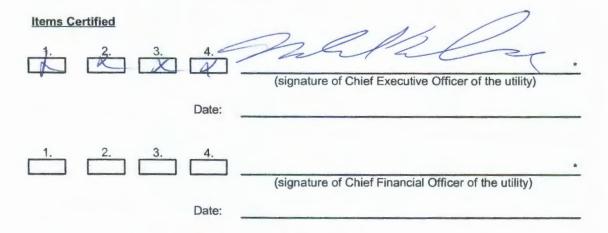

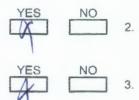

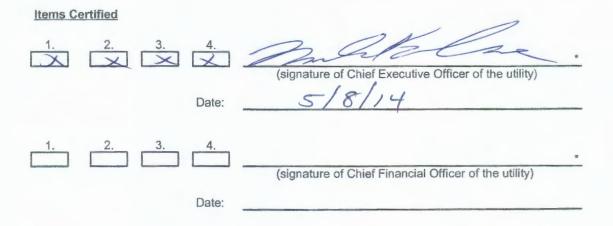
