EFFLUENT REUSE - The use of wastewater after the treatment process, generally for reuse as irrigation water or for in plant use. (Section 367.021 (6), Florida Statutes)

- (a) 350 gallons per day;

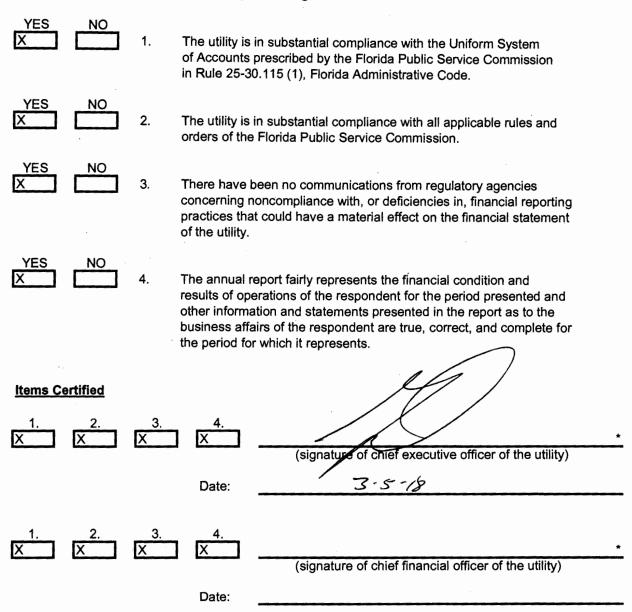
