

# SAVE MONEY!

## ON YOUR LOCAL PHONE SERVICE

The **Lifeline Assistance Program** provides up to a **\$13.50** credit on qualified residential customers' local monthly phone bills.

**Link-Up Florida** provides a **50%** reduction in the telephone service hook-up charge, up to a maximum of **\$30.00**.

*Making telephone service affordable to low-income consumers in our state.*

**You may be eligible for savings if you receive benefits under one of these programs:**

- ◆ Temporary Cash Assistance
- ◆ Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- ◆ Medicaid
- ◆ Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)
- ◆ Federal Public Housing Assistance (Section 8)
- ◆ Food Stamps
- ◆ National School Lunch Program (NSLP) - Free Lunch
- ◆ Bureau of Indian Affairs Programs
- ◆ Tribal Temporary Assistance for Needy Families
- ◆ Head Start Subsidy
- ◆ National School Lunch Program (NSLP)

**If you are at or below 150% of the poverty level, but not currently receiving benefits from one of the listed programs, you may be able to qualify by contacting the Office of Public Counsel in Tallahassee at 1-800-540-7039.**

**Some wireless and competitive local exchange companies (CLECs) also offer the Link-Up Florida and Lifeline Assistance Programs.**
