(Hearing commenced at 8:30 a.m.)

COMMISSIONER EASLEY: We'll call the hearing to order. Counselor, would you read the notice, please?

MR. HATCH: Pursuant to notice this time and place has been set for an additional prehearing conference in Docket 891194-TL, the Caller ID proceeding with Southern Bell.

COMMISSIONER EASLEY: Take appearances, please.

MR. KEENER: E. Barlow Keener, Suite 1910, 150 West Flagler Street, Miami, Florida 33130, appearing on behalf of Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company.

COMMISSIONER EASLEY: Thank you.

MR. FALGOUST: Good morning. David M. Falgoust, on behalf of the Southern Bell Telephone & Telegraph, Suite 4300, 675 West Peachtree Street Atlanta, Georgia 30375.

MS. CASWELL: Kimberly Caswell, GTE Florida, Post Office Box 110, Mail Code 7, Tampa, Florida 33601.

MR. MATHUES: Good morning. Stephen S. Mathues, 2737 Centerview Drive, Suite 309, Knight Building, Tallahassee 32399-0950, representing the Department of General Services.

1 COMMISSIONER EASLEY: Thank you.

2 MR. BECK: Charles J. Beck, Office the Public  
3 Counsel, 111 West Madison Street, Room 812,  
4 Tallahassee, Florida 32399-1400, representing Florida  
5 Citizens.

6 MR. DORAN: Richard Doran, Florida Attorney

18 Mr. Hatch, anything preliminary?

19 MR. HATCH: Yes, ma'am. It appears that in  
20 the course of the discovery process in the depositions  
21 that Southern Bell and Public Counsel have worked out  
22 an agreement that may very well limit or obviate the  
23 necessity for an additional hearing. They can probably  
24 take that up now. All the other parties, of course,  
25 are affected by this. So they need to --

1 COMMISSIONER EASLEY: By all means.

2 Take it up now.

3 Who's going to --

4 MR. BECK: Commissioner Easley, pursuant to our  
5 admonition to the parties to cooperate, we've held six  
6 depositions. Southern Bell and our office, at least, have  
7 agreed, subject to your approval and the approval of the  
8 other parties also, that we would offer the depositions  
9 and the exhibits to the depositions in evidence, and then  
10 brief it under the schedule that now exists. I've talked  
11 to the court reporter and she said they could have the  
12 transcripts prepared by the date the hearing is scheduled  
13 now to be heard so that's our proposal.

14 COMMISSIONER EASLEY: Excellent.

15 MR. KEENER: I support the proposal.

16 COMMISSIONER EASLEY: Great. Are the other  
17 parties familiar with the proposal. Any objections?  
18 Any problems?

19 (No response.)

20 Fantastic.

21 MR. HATCH: Sounds good to me.

22 COMMISSIONER EASLEY: So that would mean that  
23 the depo's in their entirety and the documents attached  
24 thereto will be entered into the record.

25 Excellent.

1 MR. HATCH: There is one other item that's  
2 sort of left hanging out there. There was one item on  
3 which the ruling was deferred at the last -- when you  
4 issued your order, I think in the Brown letter. Has  
5 that been worked out?

6 COMMISSIONER EASLEY: That's No. 11, is that  
7 correct?

8 MR. BECK: We're not going to pursue that.

9 MR. HATCH: Okay.

10 COMMISSIONER EASLEY: So that now has been  
11 dropped?

12 MR. BECK: Yes.

13 COMMISSIONER EASLEY: All right. We'll show  
14 Document No. 11 in the second draft, I guess,  
15 Prehearing Conference Order will be dropped.

16 All right.

17 Anything else?

18 MR. FALGOUST: Commissioner Easley, Southern  
19 Bell's witnesses did not waive their right to read and  
20 sign the depositions. I don't know exactly when the  
21 reporter will get the transcripts to us, but I will make a  
22 commitment to you and to all the other parties that the  
23 reading and signing of those deposition transcripts will  
24 be expedited so that we can get them turned around and  
25 filed into the record.

1           COMMISSIONER EASLEY: And any errata sheets  
2 can be in as quickly as possible.

3           MR. HATCH: The next step, I guess, is probably  
4 to run it -- I will speak to the Chairman to get it on as  
5 an emergency item if the other Commissioners will agree to  
6 this, thereby be able to cancel that hearing that's set up  
7 down at the back end.

8           COMMISSIONER EASLEY: Excellent.

9           MR. KEENER: What do you mean by expedited?

10          MR. HATCH: We've got an agenda coming up  
11 next week. I can get it on as an emergency item on  
12 that agenda.

13          COMMISSIONER EASLEY: There's no way to put  
14 it on tomorrow -- I mean Tuesday. Is that the one  
15 you're talking about?

16          MR. HATCH: That's the one I'm trying to get  
17 it on; as an addendum to that agenda.

18          COMMISSIONER EASLEY: All right. That'd be great.

19          MR. HATCH: So everybody is on board right of  
20 front, as fast as we can get it, and everybody knows  
21 what's happening. If the Commissioners agree to that,  
22 then the Chairman can cancel that hearing.

23          COMMISSIONER EASLEY: Yeah. I would hope  
24 that we can do that. Will the Chairman not be back  
25 until Monday?

1 MR. HATCH: My understanding is he's supposed  
2 to be back today, but I'm not sure. We'll track him  
3 down as fast as we can.

4 COMMISSIONER EASLEY: All right. Let's see  
5 if we can get to him today or Monday at the latest and  
6 get that scheduled if we possibly can. All right.  
7 Anything else?

8 MR. HATCH: As far as I know, that's it.

9 COMMISSIONER EASLEY: Good heavens. Well, if  
10 the admonition to the parties to go cooperate is what  
11 resulted in this, you can look forward to more  
12 admonitions. I appreciate it very much. Thank you.  
13 Hearing is adjourned.


