This letter is intended to serve as a record of our telephone conversation and to clarify any ambiguities resulting from that conversation. If this letter contradicts your memory of our conversation, or if you have further questions, please feel free to contact me. Please note that this informal communication is only extended as a courtesy and has no legal or official significance.

As you are aware, the staff is recommending that the Commission order you to show cause why you should not be fined for failure to file your annual report. Please note that at this time we are not recommending that the Commission impose a fine. Commission is free to approve the recommendation, modify the recommendation, or deny the recommendation. For the purposes of this letter, let us assume that the Commission approves the recommendation. The Commission will issue an order within 20 days of their decision. As currently contemplated, the Order will provide you with four alternatives:

You may simply pay the fine within 20 days, retain your

APP ——— :	 You may choose to respond to the Order. A response must be in writing and filed within 20 days of the date of the
