Subject: ~~Docket No. 910072-WU~~, Application for a Limited Proceeding Rate Increase in Volusia County.

We have received the revised tariff sheets and proposed customer notice. This increase was filed under Section 367.0822, Florida Statutes, Limited Proceeding and not Section 367.081, Florida Statutes, which is the indexing provision of the statute. The proposed customer notice is for an index increase and is not sufficient.

The following proposed wording is suggested for the notice. A revised notice should be prepared and submitted to the Commission, at the same time the notice is mailed to the customers.

- ACK _____ Section 367.0822, Florida Statutes, allows the Commission upon petition or by
 - AFA _____ its own motion, to conduct a limited proceeding to consider, and act upon, any
 - APP _____ matter within its jurisdiction, including any matter the resolution of which
 - CAF _____ requires a utility to adjust its rates. The matter of rate of return must be a
 - CMU _____ component of the proceeding.
 - CTR _____ The Department of Environmental Regulation (DER) has required the utility
 - EAG _____ to install an auxiliary generator, with automatic start-up capabilities. On
 - LEG _____ January 18, 1991, the utility filed an application for a limited proceeding rate
 - LIN _____ increase. The application was completed on March 22, 1991. Since the
 - CPC _____ operational cost increase has a substantial effect on the utility's ability to
 - ROH _____ recover its expenses and earn a fair rate of return on its investment from the
 - SZC / _____ existing rates, the utility filed its application under Section 367.0822, Florida
 - WAS _____ Statutes. The increase in rates as a result of this application will be 2.74%,
 - OTH _____ monthly. These rates will be effective for bills for meter readings thirty (30)
- _____ days on or after July 3, 1991.
