I. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

AUDIT PURPOSE: We have applied the procedures described in Section II of the report to the appended Exhibits for the Requested AFUDC Rate filed by the Florida Power and Light Company in support of Docket 910443–EI for the 13 month average ended December 31, 1990 to determine that exhibits represent utility books and that records are maintained in compliance with Commission directives; that adjustments are based on supportable facts and assumptions; and that facts wh which may influence the Commission decision are disclosed.

SCOPE LIMITATION: The Company waived the exit conference.

DISCLAIM PUBLIC USE: This is an internal accounting report prepared after performing a limited scope audit; accordingly, this document must not be relied upon for any purpose except to assist the Commission staff in the performance of their duties. Substantial additional work would have to be performed to satisfy generally accepted auditing standards and produce audited financial statements for public use.

OPINION: Subject to the procedures described in Section II, the appended AFUDC Rate Schedules as of December 31, 1990, represent books and records maintained in substantial compliance with Commission directives.

II. AUDIT SCOPE

This report is based on the audit work described below. When used in this section of the report Compiled defines completed audit work as:

COMPILED: means that the audit staff reconciled exhibit amounts with the general ledger; visually scanned accounts for error, irregularity or inconsistency; and, except as otherwise noted performed no other audit work.

Compiled the company's 13 month average capital structure schedules. Traced to Consolidated Balance Sheet; traced two months of the Consolidated Balance Sheet to the Utility's General Ledger. Tested selected adjustments; recalculated and agreed to Order 23144. Traced capital structure cost rates to supporting documentation. Recalculated capital ratios, AFUDC components and gross AFUDC rates. Analyzed methodology used by FPL to determine the AFUDC requested rate. Calculated the change in dollar amounts of AFUDC allowed, based on requested increase.
