25-9.053 <u>Filing and Evaluation of Information to Accompany</u>
Submittals.

- (1) Each letter transmitting a utility's proposed documentation in which any change in rate structure is proposed shall be accompanied by the following items in connection with each new and existing service classification:
- (1) As applicable a tabulation setting forth, at appropriate consumption levels, the charges applicable under the present and proposed rate together with the difference expressed in dollars and in percent; and
- (2) Supporting information in sufficient detail as to allow the Commission to determine the derivation of all rate structure modifications. The supporting information shall consist of either a utility-specific cost study or an analysis of utility-specific cost and operating data prepared using a methodology previously approved by the Commission for any comparable utility. All additional relevant information deemed necessary by the Commission shall be submitted in addition to the above upon request.
