PETITION FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE

NOW COMES AT&T Communications of the Southern States, Inc. (hereinafter "AT&T"), and, pursuant to Rule 25-22.039, Florida Administrative Code, files this Petition for Leave to Intervene in the above referenced docket. AT&T respectfully requests that the Florida Public Service Commission (hereinafter the "Commission") grant such intervention and afford AT&T all rights of a party of record under the Florida Statutes and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure. In support of its petition, AT&T respectfully shows as follows:

2. AT&T's representative to whom all pleadings, notices, orders, and other correspondence should be addressed is:


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3. AT&T is an interexchange telecommunications carrier (hereinafter "IXC"), duly certificated by the Commission, pursuant to Section 364.337, Florida Statutes, to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in Florida. As an IXC, AT&T must utilize the services of local access vendors, including Local Exchange Telecommunications companies (hereinafter "LECs") and Alternative Access Vendors (hereinafter "AAVs") in the completion of interexchange calls.

4. This case involves a petition filed by Intermedia Communications of Florida, Inc. (hereinafter "Intermedia") seeking an order of the Commission mandating that LECs file tariff revisions necessary to allow AAVs to provide authorized intrastate services through collocation arrangements to be established within LEC central offices. The outcome of this proceeding is likely to affect the manner in which AT&T obtains local exchange access services in the future, and could also affect the cost of local exchange access services which AT&T must use in the provision of intrastate interexchange telecommunications services. Consequently, AT&T's substantial interests will be affected by the outcome of this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, AT&T Communications of the Southern States, Inc. respectfully requests that the Florida Public Service Commission grant its Petition for Leave to Intervene in the above referenced docket and afford it all rights of a party of record under the Florida Statutes and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure.

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
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
