RE: Waste water treatment plant- St.George Island

I am a home owner on St.George island Plantation and am writing to object to a waste water treatment plant which is currently being planned in the Resort Village development. This site is located directly adjacent to a residential neighborhood which is also in an environmentally sensitive area and is also adjacent to to state land purchased for protection of environment and the bay.

This area is prone to flooding during rainy season , we do have concerns about odors, spills, flooding and the like.

The DEP has stated that water resources are not available for large density development on St.George Isand. As a resident I can remember a number of times in the last few years that the water supply has been off for extended periods of time due to overuse. I feel that a hotel,condo or other high density uses would cause great problems for the island in the longrun due to lack of water.

A critical review is needed as soon as possible because a hearing of the Franklin County is scheduled for Dec. 7,1993. We would greatly appreciate a timely review. Please keep me informed of any action of the PSC on this application.
