PETITION FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE

Pursuant to Rule 25-22.039, Florida Administrative Code, the Florida Cable Telecommunications Association, Inc. ("FCTA"), hereby petitions for leave to intervene in the above-captioned proceeding. In support of this petition, FCTA states:

3. It is generally recognized that cable companies are well-positioned to compete with the LECs as facilities-based competitors. Moreover, many of the certificated ALECs and AAVs in Florida are either owned by or affiliated with cable companies. All of these companies are and will be directly and substantially affected by the Commission's ruling in this proceeding as they will need to purchase unbundled services, features, functions, and capabilities from the LECs in order to do business.

4. This docket was opened for the purpose of resolving petition(s) to establish nondiscriminatory rates, terms and conditions for unbundling and resale of LEC services, features, functions and capabilities. ALECs must use the LEC network facilities to reach customers. The issues in this docket impact those services and the ALEC's ability to deliver telecommunications services to its customers. Consequently, all current and future local providers will be affected by the outcome of this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated herein, FCTA respectfully requests that the Commission grant this Petition for Leave to Intervene and that FCTA be given all rights of a party to this proceeding.
