MOTION TO DISMISS

Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") pursuant to Rule 25-22.037, Florida

Administrative Code moves to dismiss the petition for declaratory statement filed by Clay Electric

Cooperative, Inc. ("Clay") and in support thereof states:

- On Friday, April 25, 1997, Clay, via U.S. Mail, served a petition for declaratory statement on the Commission and FPL. The sole relief requested in the petition is to determine whether a territorial dispute exists under an alleged set of facts pertaining to certain area in Baker County where FPL and Clay currently provide service. FPL contests the majority of alleged facts Clay relies upon in seeking a declaratory statement from the Commission.
- On Tuesday, April 29, 1997, FPL filed a Petition with the Commission to Resolve a Territorial Dispute with Clay in Baker County.
- Notwithstanding FPL's disagreement as to the salient facts at issue in Clay's Petition, FPL's filing of the territorial dispute with the Commission renders Clay's Petition for Declaratory statement moot.
- 4 Even if Clay's Petition were not moot, the Petition is framed in such a way as that it is not confined to a set of specific facts and a specific petitioner, but instead would require such a broad response as to necessitate the promulgation of a rule defining when a territorial dispute exists. Agencies such as the Commission may not use the declaratory statement provisions of Section 120.565, Florida Statutes (1995), derivatively promulgated by the Commission as Rule

25-22.020, Fla. Admin. Code, as a short cut to announce a rule. Florida Optometric Association v. Department of Professional Regulation, Board of Opticianry, 567 So. 2d 928 (Fla. 1st DCA 1990). As the Commission can more than adequately resolve the issues presented by Clay in its Petition via resolution of the territorial dispute filed by FPL the Commission should refrain from entertaining Clay's Petition. Couch v. State, 377 So. 2d 32 (1979).
