Recommendation: Yes. Collected fines are to be paid to the Florida Public Service Commission and forwarded to the Office of the Comptroller for deposit in the General Revenue Fund pursuant to 364.285(1), F.S.

Issue 2: Should these dockets be closed?

Recommendation: Yes. These dockets should be closed if no person whose substantial interests are affected files a protest within 21 days of issuance of the order. If no timely protest is filed, the certificates should be canceled and these dockets closed at the conclusion of the 30-day period after the order becomes final. If a company pays the \$250 fine, submits the regulatory assessment fee, along with the statutory penalties and interest charges, and provides the information required, the docket should be closed. A protest of one docket should not prevent this order from becoming final for the other docket.
