 The Commission has opened the above-captioned docket for the purpose stated therein. Section 282.103(1), <u>Florida Statutes</u>, provides:

There is created within the Division of Communications of the Department of Management Services the SUNCOM Network which shall be developed to serve as the state communications system for providing local and long-distance communications services to state agencies, political subdivisions of the state, municipalities, and nonprofit corporations pursuant to ss. 282.101-282.111.

- 4. Section 364.515, <u>Florida Statutes</u>, further specifies the duties of DMS relating to the establishment and implementation of advanced telecommunications services for eligible facilities in great detail. DMS therefore has an interest in this proceeding as it may impact the SUNCOM Network and its users, especially including eligible facilities, thereby substantially affecting DMS' and the current and prospective users' interests.
- 5. The overall interests of DMS and the eligible facilities are not adequately represented by any other party to this proceeding. While other intervenors represent similar interests, none is charged with the wide-ranging duties provided for DMS in Section 364.515.
 Florida Statues.

WHEREFORE, the Department of Management Services requests intervention in this docket.
