**BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC.'S
REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION**

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"), hereby files pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Division Code, its Request for Confidential Classification, and states the following.

1. On August 22, 1997, the Deposition of Gloria Calhoun was taken. On August 29, 1997, and September 2, and 3, 1997 the late-filed Deposition Exhibits of Gloria Calhoun were filed along with a Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification for the subject information on late-filed Deposition Exhibit Nos. 5, 6, and 8, respectively. Additionally, BellSouth withdraws its Notice of Intent for late-filed Deposition Exhibit No. 1 filed on August 28, 1997.

2. The information contained in the late-filed Deposition Exhibit Nos. 5, 6, and 8 is proprietary and entails information that is clearly confidential and proprietary under Florida Statutes, Section 364.183.

3. Because the late-filed deposition exhibits contain proprietary information, BellSouth is filing this Request for Specified Confidential Classification, pursuant to

Rule 25-22.006(3), Florida Administrative Code. The original of this notice has been filed with the Division of Records and Reporting.

4. BellSouth has appended to this Request for Confidential Classification as "Attachment A" a listing showing the location in the response of the information designated by BellSouth as confidential.

5. Appended hereto in an envelope designated as "Attachment B" is two copies of the response with the confidential information deleted.

6. Attached as "Attachment C" is a sealed envelope containing one copy of the response with the material which is confidential and proprietary. Copies of "Attachment C" are not being served on the other parties in this proceeding.

7. BellSouth has treated and intends to continue to treat the material for which confidential classification is sought as private, and this information has not been generally disclosed.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, BellSouth moves the Commission to enter an order declaring the information described above to be confidential proprietary business information, and thus not subject to public disclosure.

Explanation for Proprietary Information
