RE: DOCKET NO. 970544-EG - Petition by Florida Power & Light Company for approval of Commercial/Industrial Building Envelope program.

Issue 1: Should the Commission approve Florida Power & Light Company's petition for approval to modify its Commercial/Industrial Building Envelope program, including approval for cost recovery through the Energy Conservation Cost Recovery Clause?

Recommendation: Yes. However, because the C/I Building Envelope program is marginally cost-effective, FPL should reassess the cost-effectiveness of the program and report, in its true-up filing in Docket No. 980002-EG in November 1998, the resulting cost-effectiveness ratios using the most current assumptions at the time the analysis is performed. FPL should also report to staff the results of its planned 1998 evaluation of the C/I Building Envelope program.
