**BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC.'S NOTICE OF
INTENT TO REQUEST SPECIFIED CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION**

COMES NOW, BellSouth Telecommunications, inc. ("BellSouth" or "Company"), and pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, files its Notice of Intent to Request Specified Confidential Classification.

1. On December 3, 1997, BellSouth filed its responses to WorldCom's Second Set of Interrogatories and Second Requests for Production of Documents. Item No. 17 requested information concerning the underlying cost of the nonrecurring rates BellSouth charges its retail customers. The information responsive to this request contains cost information that is considered to be confidential and proprietary to BellSouth.

2. In its Fourth Request for Production, the Staff requested proprietary information in Item No. 59 (produced in response to WorldCom's Second Set of Interrogatories, Item No. 17), Item No. 52a which contains vendor specific cost information and in Staff's Fourth Request for Interrogatories Item No. 71b, which was a request for documents, contains *proprietary cost information*. The information contained in the responsive documents is proprietary to BellSouth and includes *commercially sensitive* information containing, among other things, the cost associated with BellSouth's retail operations and vendor specific pricing information. The disclosure of such information would be prejudicial to BellSouth. Such

information is clearly confidential and proprietary under Florida Statutes, Section 364.183 and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code.

4. Because this information contains proprietary information, BellSouth is filing this Notice of Intent to Request Specified Confidential Classification, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), Florida Administrative Code, in order to allow the Commission to take possession of the responses without delay. The original of this notice has been filed with the Division of Records and Reporting, and a copy has been served on the Division requesting the information.

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
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
